

Using a DEFAULT Transfer Articulation Table in DARwin

**Use this functionality to decrease transfer articulation table maintenance
for schools with common catalogs**


Sometimes institutions have multiple campuses or locations and transcripts come from the individual campuses, yet the institution uses the same curriculum for these multiple campuses. Using the Default field in the Institutional Reference tables allows the encoder or transfer specialist to identify the student's campus, but maintain only one set of transfer articulation rules for the overall institution(s).

Encoding occurs in:

Institutional Reference tables

The example demonstrates assigning a Default Transfer Articulation Table directly on an Institutional Reference table. In this example, Rasmussen College-Mankato (FICE 025033), Rasmussen College-Eagan (FICE 004648), Rasmussen College-St. Cloud (FICE 008694), and Rasmussen College-Minnetonka (FICE 011686) share a common curriculum. Each evaluated course will carry the transfer institution identification code (Report InstID) associated with the source course.

Each institution requires an Institutional Reference Table.





The Institutional Reference tables for Rasmussen College-Eagan, -St. Cloud, -Minnetonka, and -Mankato uses the Transfer Articulation Table where the articulations are listed. Curriculum changes for the Rasmussen schools occur on the Default Transfer Articulation Table only.

Transfer Articulation rules for Rasmussen-Eagan, -Mankato, -Minnetonka, and -St. Cloud reside on the Source ID of 004648, Rasmussen – Eagan.

In our example, the transfer articulation rules for the Rasmussen Colleges (above) are contained in Rasmussen College-Eagan (FICE 004648). The default InstID of 004648 must be inserted in the Default Transfer Articulation Table for Rasmussen-St.Cloud, Rasmussen-Minnetonka, and Rasmussen-Minnetonka. The Default Transfer Articulation Table field points to the Transfer Articulation Source ID 004648 for Rasmussen College, Eagan.
