Level I identifies tasks that are taught in the classroom; the individual is able to perform simple parts of tasks. Level II identifies those tasks that are part of on-the-job training; the trainee can do most tasks pertaining to a particular system and needs supervision on more difficult parts of tasks. Level III indicates that the individual can perform all essential tasks without supervision. Level IV indicates a high level of proficiency in job performance; the individual can perform advanced technical functions, instruction, inspection, and supervision.
