



To make your transfer to ([your college/university name](#)) as easy as possible, ([your college/university name](#)) has partnered with Transferology – a nation-wide network designed to help answer the question “Will my courses transfer?” If you are interested in transferring credit to ([your college/university name](#)), we encourage you to create a Transferology account, add or import your coursework, find out how your courses might transfer, and find out how your courses apply to a program or variety of programs. You can also create future coursework and program scenarios. Transferology also provides information on transfer of military credits and standardized exams, including advanced placement and college level exams.

How to create a Transferology account

You can create a Transferology account in just a few easy steps:

- Go to www.transferology.com
- Click the 'Create an account' link
- Enter your information
- Record your user ID (e-mail address you use to create the account) and password in a safe place

Transferology Tips

As a student, when you enter courses in your Transferology account you will be able to view matches for schools that participate in Transferology. Schools are ranked by the percentage of coursework they accept in transfer, though you may focus the results with a number of handy filters and sorts, including how your courses transfer into a specific program at another college or university.

Matches: Indicates the specific courses you may be awarded after transferring, providing you have earned a grade that is passing and high enough for specific program requirements.

Misses: Two types of misses are listed: courses that will not transfer and those that will transfer to this school if you take additional coursework (shown in gray).

Maybe: These are courses that have not been reviewed by ([your college/university name](#)) yet to determine transferability. View our ([??? transfer credit policy and guidelines link here ???](#)) for information about how to request additional information regarding transfer.
